


Haynes Manuals AllAccess

Access Haynes Manuals AllAccess


Unitec staff and students will be able to access the manuals directly from the Library website (from subject guide or Database A-Z). Access is available both on campus and off campus, using Unitec network login.



Insert your prefered car make and model, then click the Search button. All versions will appear and select the one you are looking for.

Useful tips:

- You can click 'Cars' once you are in the manual to change and select a different makes and models. Or just click Haynes Manuals AllAcces to start a new search.
- Most content in 'View online manual' are NOT in our subscription. Open 'View online manual' in a new tab so that you have both the Manual and new link open.
- The 'Go back to Haynes Manuals' button will bring back to the main page where you need to search from the beginning.

The **Unitec Library** subscribes to SafetyHub which you can use while studying here.


SafetyHub is a database on workplace safety training video content prepared by Safetycare, a company set up to provide safety training products and services. SafetyHub has 141 videos (as of July 2023) with duration ranging between 10 to 20 minutes. The videos cover 17 different areas.

- Login your Unitec username and password if required.

Autodata

The Unitec – Te Pūkenga Library subscribes to Autodata which you can use while studying here.

Autodata is an online tool for workshop technicians to help service, repair and diagnose automotive work. Autodata contains information on thousands of models of cars from more than 50 manufacturers.

Username & Password to access Autodata

Unitec staff and students will be able to access Autodata link from the Library website (from Automotive Subject Guide or Database A-Z). You will need to use a temporary username and password to access Autodata.

Find current usernames and passwords by clicking a padlock

icon in next to Autodata link, which will bring you to the **Unitec** Library – database access Moodle course. Once you are in the Moodle course, scroll down to find Autodata and link to the latest username list.





- If your selected *username* does not work, another student may be using it. Please try another username from the list.




Using Autodata

To start, select **Technical Information**.



You will then be able to select the type of vehicle you are interested in. You can search by vehicle code OR by model.



- Select the vehicle you are interested in. You will see the Technical Information that is available from the manufacturer for this vehicle. Enjoy!
